

City of Placerville Parking Ordinance #1612 FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

- **When will the new parking ordinance take effect?**

January 2, 2007

- **Will there be parking meters on Main Street?**

No. Main Street will remain 2 hours free parking with no meters or pay boxes. If you want to stay longer, use a parking lot.

- **Will there still be free parking?**

Yes. Main Street and the surface parking lots will continue to have 2 hours free parking (unless otherwise marked). Only the parking lots will have pay boxes allowing you to pay to park longer than 2 hours. 8 hour free parking is located at the Placerville Station on Mosquito Rd.

- **How much will it cost to park in the parking lots?**

Parking for longer than 2 hours will cost \$1 per hour.

- **Will all lots have pay boxes?**

No. The Town Hall and small Center Street Lot will remain 2 hours free parking only. The 3rd floor of the Center Street Garage will be limited to permit parking only. The 1st and 2nd floor of the garage, and the surface lots on Main Street and Sacramento Street will have 2 hours free and pay boxes located in each lot to purchase additional time.

- **What are the hours and days of enforcement?**

8AM until 5PM Monday through Saturday.

- **Why not use a local parking consultant?**

Diamond Parking is the only company in California (to date) that can both issue citations and access DMV records to process citations.

- **Will customers have to use the Placerville Station and shuttle into town?**

No. While the free parking and shuttle service is designed for employee and jury parking, it can certainly be used by anyone wishing to park 8 hours or less for free and take the shuttle to Old City Hall.

- **What are the shuttle hours of operation?**

The shuttle will operate Monday through Friday, from 7:30AM until 6:30PM, every 30 minutes except for peak hours (7:30-9AM, 11-1PM,

and 4:30-6:30PM) when it will run every 15 minutes.
