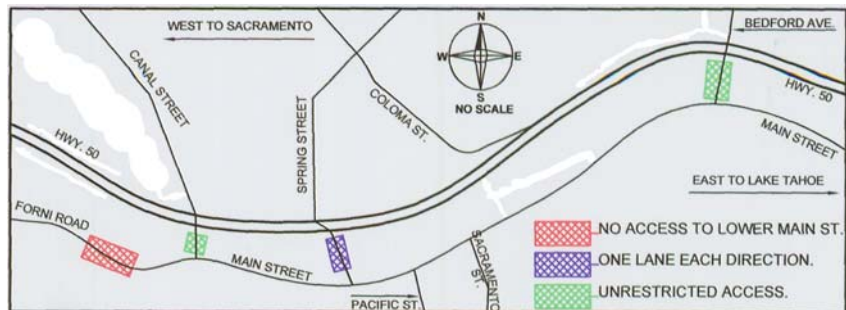

### Getting Around Town

Work on the improvements to U.S. 50 through town continues, and may occasionally affect traffic.

#### Lower Main Street and Forni Road

The new connection between Placerville Drive and Main St. is being completed, and during September and October, the whole area where Forni Road joins Main Street is being rebuilt. Parts of Forni Road have to be closed during that rebuild. Most businesses on Lower Main Street can be reached from Main Street. An auto repair shop on Forni Road, however, is just on the other side of that construction area. To get to that shop, use Placerville Drive to Ray Lawyer Drive. At the top of Ray Lawyer Drive, where it passes over US50, it ends at Forni Road. Turn left and follow Forni Road to the construction area...and the auto repair shop.



#### Spring Street Bridge

Spring Street bridge, at the intersection of Hwy. 49 and US50 will be widened during September and October. During construction, one of the two northbound lanes on the bridge will be closed, with one lane open in each direction. Congestion is expected to occur primarily in the late afternoon hours. During those times, you may want to use the Canal St. or Bedford St. bridges.

#### Highway 50

Next up are improvements to the main US50 roadway. Crews will be working at nights, so from 8:00 p.m. to 6:00 a.m., the right-most lane (the slow lane) on US50 may be closed in one or both directions. If you're traveling on US50 in evenings or wee hours, be sure to plan for a few minutes of possible slowdown.
