Placerville Historic Markers Inventory is a co-initiated project by Stanley W. Morris and Dee Owens.

The project's goal is to identify, record, and inventory, with high-quality mapping tools, all of the City of Placerville's historic markers and monuments. Utilizing GPS devices, existing information, MS Excel, and online mapping applications (see Google Map link at the bottom of document), data on all accessible historic sites and locations with markers will be collected, organized, and published. The project, presented to the City of Placerville's Historical Advisory Committee on January 17, 2013, is an independent effort of the project initiators to support and enhance historical preservation and improve the experience of local tourism.
