**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE  
CITY OF PLACERVILLE APPROVING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH DOUG  
VEERKAMP GENERAL ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$169,999.87 AND  
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE ANY NECESSARY CONTRACT  
CHANGE ORDERS FOR A NOT-TO-EXCEED AGGREGATE AMOUNT OF \$5,000 FOR THE  
PACIFIC STREET PAVMENT REHABILITATION-FROM CLARK STREET TO CEDAR  
RAVINE PROJECT  
(CIP # 41905)**

**WHEREAS**, the Measures H/L Sales Tax Committee recommended that the City Council approve a \$180,000 Measure L Fund budget appropriation for the Pacific Street Pavement Rehabilitation-From Clark Street to Cedar Ravine Road project as part of the Fiscal Year 2018/2019 Capital Improvement Program at its meeting held on May 17, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council approved the 2018/2019 Fiscal Year Capital Improvement Program Budget which appropriated \$180,000 in Measure L funds for the Pacific Street Pavement Rehabilitation-From Clark Street to Cedar Ravine Project (CIP #41905) on June 26, 2018; and

**WHEREAS**, the City solicited informal bids from contractors and received one bid from Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. in the amount of \$169,999.87 for the said project; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has identified necessary public domestic water service replacements in the field that will be addressed during construction to deliver a more complete and durable project.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Approve a Construction Contract for Pacific Street Pavement Rehabilitation-From Clark Street to Cedar Ravine Road project (CIP #41905) with Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. (DVGE), in the amount of \$169,999.87; and
2. Authorize the City Manager to negotiate any necessary Contract Change Orders for the said project for a not-to-exceed aggregate amount of \$5,000.
