

RESOLUTION NO. ____**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
WAIVING THE 60-DAY NOTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS AS ALLOWED IN
GOVERNMENT CODE §25351 FOR PROPERTY LOCATED AT
772 PACIFIC STREET**

WHEREAS, the governing body of the City of Placerville, hereinafter referred to as “Council”, is granted authority under Government Code §25351, to waive a 60-day notification period requirement, allowing El Dorado County to lease a building within the Placerville City limits; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County desires to enter into a lease for real property located at 772 Pacific Street, Placerville; and

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville is willing to waive the 60-day notification period for said proposed lease, pursuant to Government Code §25351.

BE IT, AND IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville waives the 60-day notification period required under Government Code §25351, to allow El Dorado County to move forward in executing a lease for 772 Pacific Street, Placerville, CA 95667.
