PART-TIME MAINTENANCE WORKER I (FLAGGER)

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Under the direction of the Public Works Superintendent or designee, the Maintenance Worker I (Flagger) is responsible for various traffic control set-ups, work zone safety, signs, flagging and flagging procedures.

This position is ideal for an individual interested in starting a career in Public Works Street Maintenance. The Maintenance Worker I (Flagger) must enjoy working outside in all weather conditions. This position may require the need to stand for long periods of time in hot weather, working in close-proximity to heavy and loud equipment and in areas of high traffic doing traffic control. Training is provided by the City and no previous experience is required.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Age: Applicants must be at least 18 years of age. Training: Traffic Control Certification (desired)

Experience: Equivalent to one year of traffic control experience (desired).
