A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE APPROVING BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS TOTALING \$700,000 FOR THE THOMPSON WAY REPAVING PROJECT (CIP #42206), APPROVING BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS TOTALING \$275,000 FOR THE SHERMAN STREET REPAVING PROJECT (CIP #42208), APPROVING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH C.E. COX GENERAL ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$528,340 FOR THE THOMPSON WAY REPAVING PROJECT (CIP #42206) AND \$184,650 FOR THE SHERMAN STREET REPAVING PROJECT (CIP #42208) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS UP TO \$25,000 PER CHANGE ORDER FOR AN AGGREGATE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$106,000 FOR THE THOMPSON WAY REPAVING PROJECT (CIP #42206) AND \$40,000 FOR THE SHERMAN STREET REPAVING PROJECT (CIP #42208)

WHEREAS, the adopted Fiscal Year 2021/2022 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget establishing the Thompson Way Repaving project (CIP #42206) and the Sherman Street Repaving project (CIP #42208) as locally-funded Measure L pavement reconstruction and maintenance projects; and

WHEREAS, the adopted Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Budget establishing the Sheridan Street Paving Project (CIP #42324); and

WHEREAS, at the meeting held on May 28, 2024, the City Council approved a Consulting Services Agreement with Rick Engineering for engineering design services to deliver construction bid documents for all the three projects; and

WHEREAS, the City recognizes the need to evaluate and rehabilitate existing sewer, water, and storm drainage facilities before paving these streets; and

WHEREAS, to construct the proposed project improvements during the summer to minimize impacts to Sierra Elementary School, the projects will be phased with underground utility work in Summer of 2025 (Phase 1) for the Thompson Way Repaving project (CIP #42206) and the Sherman Street Repaving project (CIP #42208), and the paving will be completed for all three projects in Summer of 2026 (Phase 2); and

WHEREAS, the City released construction documents for public bidding, and bids were publicly opened and read aloud on April 17, 2025, and the project is now ready to award a construction contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby

1. Approve a \$225,000 budget appropriation from the Measure L Fund for the Thompson Way Repaving Project (CIP #42206); and
2. Approve a \$400,000 budget appropriation from the Measure H Fund Construction Reserve for the Thompson Way Repaving Project (CIP #42206); and

3. Approve a \$75,000 budget appropriation from the Measure L Fund Construction Reserve for the Thompson Way Repaving Project (CIP #42206); and
4. Approve a \$25,000 budget appropriation from the Measure L Fund for the Sherman Street Repaving Project (CIP #42208); and
5. Approve a \$150,000 budget appropriation from the Measure H Fund Construction Reserve for the Sherman Street Repaving Project (CIP #42208); and
6. Approve a \$100,000 budget appropriation from the Measure L Fund Construction Reserve for the Sherman Street Repaving Project (CIP #42208); and
7. Approve a construction contract with C.E. Cox General Engineering, Inc. for the Thompson Way Repaving Project (CIP #42206) in an amount not to exceed \$528,340.00 and for the Sherman Street Repaving Project (CIP #42208) in an amount not to exceed \$184,650.00, and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
8. Authorize the City Manager contract change order authority up to \$25,000 per change order for a not to exceed aggregate amount of \$106,000 for the Thompson Way Repaving Project (CIP #42206) and \$40,000 for the Sherman Street Repaving Project (CIP #42208). Said change orders will be brought to the next available City Council meeting for approval or ratification.
