The candidates were invited to participate in a group interview so that interaction between candidates and Councilmembers could be promoted. The interviews were conducted in a public interview process with questions posed to each candidate by the City Council, and each candidate was given sufficient time to respond to the questions. At the conclusion of the group interviews, each Councilmember completed a prepared ballot that the City Manager and City Clerk tabulated. The results were then announced. The one candidate receiving the highest number of votes from at least three (3) Councilmembers was Theodore Dziuba, who was then sworn in by the City Clerk and appointed to the one unexpired term of office ending March 1, 2019.
