5.1 Adopt a Resolution:

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1. Approving a Contract Change Order with Doug Veerkamp Engineering for the Spring Street Pavement Repair from Coloma Road to Bedford Avenue Project (CIP #41907) in an amount not to exceed \$135,000 for failed water line replacement.

2. Approving a Contract Change Order with Doug Veerkamp Engineering for the Spring Street Pavement Repair from Coloma Road to Bedford Avenue Project (CIP #41907) in an amount not to exceed \$70,000 for failed storm drain line replacement.

3. Approving a budget appropriation from the Measure L Reserve Fund in the amount of \$205,000.

4. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the Contract Change Orders.

Resolution No. 8898

The City Engineer explained the contract change orders for the failed storm drain and water line replacements. Mickey Kaiserman, Sue Rodman, and Garry Silvey from the Measure H and L Sales Tax Committee were virtually present and commented on the item. No public comment was received. Following Council discussion, it was moved by Councilmember Acuna and seconded by Councilmember Borelli that the City Council adopt a resolution for the following actions:

1. Approving a Contract Change Order with Doug Veerkamp Engineering for the Spring Street Pavement Repair from Coloma Road to Bedford Avenue Project (CIP #41907) in an amount not to exceed \$135,000 for failed water line replacement; and

2. Authorizing the City Manager to approve additional water line replacement following evaluation for the remaining portion of this phase of the project up to Spring and Tunnel Street intersection, not to exceed \$70,000; and

3. Approving a budget appropriation amount up to \$275,000; and

4. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the Contract Change orders.
