### 5.1 Adopt a Resolution:

1. Authorizing the Chief of Police to negotiate a professional services agreement with the El Dorado County Fire Protection District and Dewberry Architects, Inc., for a not to exceed amount of \$178,000 for Public Safety Building Needs Assessment Study project (CIP #42020); and

2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the same; and

3. Approving a \$15,372 budget appropriation from the General Fund Contingency for Unforeseen Expenditures for the said project; and

4. Approving a \$58,628 budget appropriation from the General Fund unassigned fund balance for the said project (Chief Wren)

## Resolution No. <u>8949</u>

The Chief of Police and City Engineer presented the staff report and responded to Council questions. No public comment was received. Following Council discussion, it was moved by Vice-Mayor Taylor and seconded by Councilmember Borelli that the City Council adopt a resolution for the following actions:

1. Authorizing the Chief of Police to negotiate a professional services agreement with the El Dorado County Fire Protection District and Dewberry Architects, Inc., for a not to exceed amount of \$140,000 for Public Safety Building Needs Assessment Study project (CIP #42020); and

2. Authorizing the City Manager to execute the same; and

3. Approving a \$15,372 budget appropriation from the General Fund Contingency for Unforeseen Expenditures for the said project; and

4. Approving a \$39,628 budget appropriation from the General Fund unassigned fund balance for the said project.

After further discussion, the City Manager suggested a clarification of the motion, which should authorize the Chief of Police to negotiate a professional services agreement with the El Dorado County Fire Protection

District and Dewberry Architects, Inc., for a not to exceed amount of \$100,000 for Public Safety Building Needs Assessment Study project (CIP #42020); and authorize a contingency in the amount of \$40,000 with \$20,000 from the City of Placerville and \$20,000 from the El Dorado County Fire Protection District.

Vice-Mayor Taylor amended her motion and Councilmember Borelli amended her second.
