NOTE: There were two (2) full-terms of office available for appointment and one (1) unexpired term.

Each Council member voted for the three candidates and appointed them to the following terms:

Kelley Rogers; term expiring March 2025 Steven Vance; term expiring March 2025 Mark Sandperl; unexpired term ending March 2023
