*At the conclusion of the interviews, each Councilmember emailed their vote to the City Clerk. There were two (2) terms of office to be appointed, ending March 2025. The City Manager and City Clerk tabulated the votes and reported the results of the balloting aloud to the public. The two candidates receiving the highest number of votes from at least three (3) Councilmembers were Nicole Gotberg and Michael Frenn.*
