5.1 Consider Request by El Dorado County to Assist in Funding the Proposed Homeless Navigation Center in the Amount of \$287,500 and Authorize the City Manager to Notify the County of this Action Prior to their Board Meeting on July 26, 2022 (Mr. Morris)

The City Manager explained the item and responded to Council questions. Public comment was received from Kathi Lishman, Linda Irwin, Maureen Dion-Perry (on behalf of Housing El Dorado), Sue Rodman, District 3 Supervisor Wendy Thomas, Kirk Smith, Tim Irwin, Don Vanderkar, and Peg Vanderkar. Following Council discussion, it was moved by Vice-Mayor Saragosa and seconded by Mayor Taylor that the City Council take the following actions:

1. Authorize the payment of \$287,500 to El Dorado County as contribution toward the proposed Navigation Center to be located at Perks Court in El Dorado County; and

2. Authorize the City Manager to prepare an MOU agreeing to the payment and including the City Manager in the planning and implementation of the referral process and prioritizing the Homeless Camp on Upper Broadway in Placerville as the priority in the referral process to eliminate the camp; and

3. Approve a \$287,500 budget appropriation from the ARPA Fund undesignated fund balance for the said Navigation Center.
