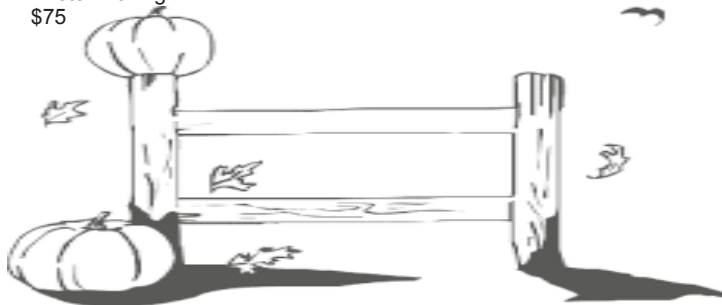

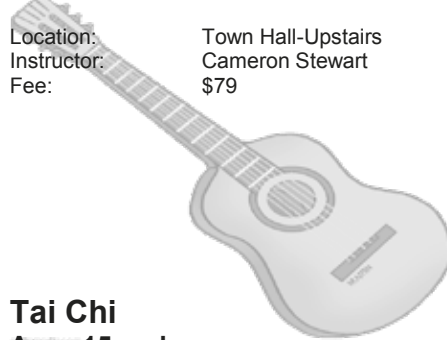


Beginning Guitar Ages 8-12

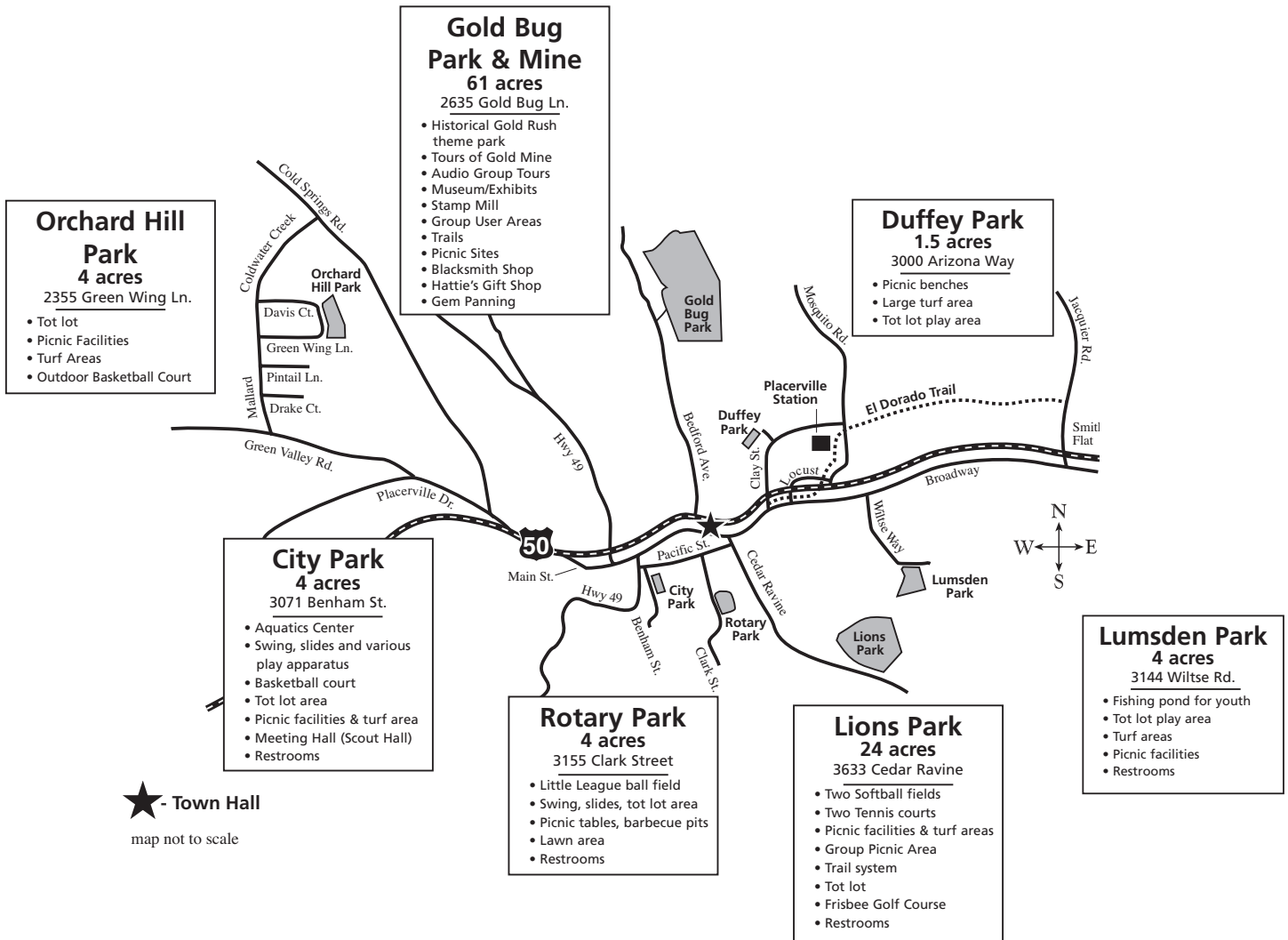
