**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE  
RATIFYING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE CALIFORNIA  
DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE FOR THE 2019-2021 PROPOSITION 56 TOBACCO  
GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$395,267, APPROVING AN ADDITIONAL PART-  
TIME COMMUNITY SERVICES OFFICER POSITION, ABOLISHING THE FULL-  
TIME BUILDING OFFICIAL POSITION, APPROVING JOB DESCRIPTION FOR  
THE CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL POSITION, APPROVING A FULL TIME  
CODE ENFORCEMENT OFFICIAL POSITION, AND APPROVING AND  
AFFIRMING A NEW SALARY SCHEDULE EFFECTIVE JUNE 1, 2019**

**WHEREAS**, the City was awarded a Tobacco Grant in the amount of \$395,267 from the California Department of Justice, Division of Law Enforcement, Tobacco Grant Unit funded through the California Health Care, Research and Prevention Tobacco Tax Act of 2016 approved by the California voters as Proposition 56; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 12, 2019 the City of Placerville Police Department and the California Department of Justice entered into a Memorandum of Understanding (DOJ-PROP56-2018-19-1-010) which expires on June 30, 2021; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Police Department and Development Services Department will work with the El Dorado County Public Health Department to reduce tobacco use by youth in El Dorado County including the City of Placerville;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby adopts a Resolution:

1. Ratifying a Memorandum of Understanding with the California Department of Justice for the 2019-2021 Department of Justice, Proposition 56 Tobacco Grant in the amount of 395,267; and
2. Approving an additional part-time (0.48 FTE) Community Services Officer position; and
3. Abolishing the full-time (1.00 FTE) Building Official position; and
4. Approving the job description for the Code Enforcement Official position; and
5. Approving a full-time (1.00 FTE) Code Enforcement Official position; and
6. Approving and affirming a salary schedule effective June 1, 2019 (Attachment "A") which reflects the salary schedule for the new Code Enforcement Official position.
