**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
RATIFYING A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH HOUSING EL
DORADO FOR USE OF 3071 BENHAM STREET FOR A TEMPORARY INCLEMENT
WEATHER OVERNIGHT WARMING CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville ("City") has a homeless population within the City limits that is in need of services; and

WHEREAS, during the winter months, the need for services increases due to inclement weather and lack of facilities; and

WHEREAS, El Dorado County is currently preparing to open a Nomadic Shelter to provide housing and services to the homeless population; and

WHEREAS, Housing El Dorado, a local non-profit, in conjunction with local churches has operated a nomadic shelter in the past to assist the homeless during winter months; and

WHEREAS, it has been determined by Housing El Dorado that it is no longer feasible to operate the nomadic shelter; and

WHEREAS, the City owns a building located at 3071 Benham Street known as Scout Hall; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to assist in providing a facility for an Inclement Weather Overnight Warming Center to the homeless during defined inclement weather conditions.

WHEREAS, the City Council ratified an MOU with HED for use of Scout Hall at 3071 Benham Street for an Inclement Weather Overnight Warming Center through January 31, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to extend the MOU through February 15, 2023:

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE DOES HEREBY RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Memorandum of Understanding executed by the City Manager on November 29, 2022 and ratified by the City Council on December 13, 2022, between the City of Placerville and Housing El Dorado for use of Scout Hall as a temporary inclement weather overnight warming center is hereby extended through February 15, 2023.
2. All other terms and conditions of the MOU shall remain as presently stated.
3. In conjunction with the said Memorandum of Understanding the following findings are made:

- a. The use of Scout Hall as an inclement weather overnight warming center is required for the proper functioning of the Community.
- b. The use of Scout Hall will be conducted so that it will not be detrimental in any way to the surrounding properties or to the community.
