Subject: Receive and File Councilmember Appointments to Other Agencies and Boards

Purpose: To notify Councilmembers and the public of the Mayor's appointments to local and regional boards, commissions, and agencies.

Strategic Goal: None.

Background: At the regularly scheduled City Council meeting following the appointment of a new Mayor in January, the Mayor has the responsibility to assign Councilmembers to other agency Committees and Commissions. The Mayor has traditionally solicited Councilmember preferences for serving on other governmental and quasi-governmental-agency commissions and boards based on Councilmember interest and availability. The composition of these El Dorado County and multi-agency commissions and boards allows its voting members to be elected officials. It is in the City's best interest to retain an elected official to represent our jurisdiction when working with other agencies' elected officials. The appointments can remain the same as the year prior, or new appointments can be made.

Additionally, the City's Abandoned Vehicle Abatement Committee and the City Council Sub-Committee Interview Team are also requiring appointments this year.


Discussion: The attached roster lists the Mayor's proposed Councilmember Committee assignments for 2023. The City retains a seat, or multiple seats, on the following Committees/Commissions: El Dorado County Transit Authority, El Dorado County Transportation Commission, Indian Gaming Local Community Benefit Committee, Local Agency Formation Commission (LAFCO), Sacramento Area Council of Governments (SACOG), Pioneer Community Energy Board of Directors, Placerville Fire Safe Council, City/County Two by Two Committee, and Opportunity Knocks/Continuum of Care. Following tonight's acknowledgement, the affected agencies will be notified by the City Clerk of the re-assignments.

Options:

1. Accept the appointments as listed on the attached roster.
2. Review the roster and make new appointments or reappointments as needed.

Budget Impact: None. The Councilmembers are not compensated by the City for their participation on these Committees.
