**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE  
DIRECTING STAFF TO PROCEED WITH DE-PROGRAMMING FUNDING  
THROUGH THE HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (HSIP) AND  
TERMINATE THE SPRING STREET AND PLEASANT STREET INTERSECTION  
SAFETY PROJECT (CIP #41926) AND APPROVING A \$19,000 BUDGET  
LIQUIDATION OF HSIP REVENUES FOR THE SAID PROJECT**

**WHEREAS**, the intersection of Spring Street and Pleasant Street has been long deemed a pedestrian safety concern and an unsafe crossing; and

**WHEREAS**, staff discussed and collectively recommended pursuing an application with the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) for funding of a potential pedestrian safety project and was successful in receiving the requested funded amount of \$113,600; and

**WHEREAS**, the City received authorization to proceed with use of said funding in the amount of \$19,000 on March 15, 2019 for the preliminary engineering phase of the project, and the City Council approved appropriation of these funds at its regularly schedule meeting on March 26, 2019; and

**WHEREAS**, staff has performed an engineering evaluation and due to safety concerns does not recommend installation of crossing improvements at this location, and recommends de-programming the HSIP funds and terminating CIP #41926:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Direct staff to proceed with de-programming funding through the Highway Safety Improvement Program and terminate the Spring Street and Pleasant Street Intersection Safety Project (CIP #41926); and
2. Approve a \$19,000 budget liquidation of HSIP revenues for the said project.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on February 14, 2023, by Councilmember \_\_\_\_\_ who moved its adoption.
