**Subject:** Confirm the Recommended Appointments to the Measures H & L Sales Tax Committee and the Placerville Economic Advisory Committee

---

**Purpose:** The purpose of this item is to facilitate the appointments and seating of public members on the City's Measures H & L Sales Tax Committee and the Placerville Economic Advisory Committee.

**Strategic Plan Strategy:** N/A

**Background:** Every two years, the City accepts applications from the public to serve on various City committees with upcoming term expirations or vacancies. In January of this year, Vice-Mayor Neau and Councilmember Yarbrough were appointed by Mayor Saragosa to serve on the City Council Interview Sub-Committee to interview applicants for these committees and make recommendations for appointments at a regularly scheduled City Council meeting.

**Discussion:** A sufficient number of applications were received for the vacancies on the Measures H & L Sales Tax Committee and the Placerville Economic Advisory Committee.

Measures H and L Sales Tax Committee:

Four (4) applications were received for three (3) seats with full four-year terms ending March 1, 2027. The four applicants met the qualification criteria as stated in Municipal Code Section 1-9-9 and are as follows:

Ryan Carter  
 Tom Cumpston (incumbent)  
 Garry Silvey (incumbent)  
 Elizabeth Zangari (incumbent)

The City Council Interview Sub-Committee chose not to conduct interviews and is recommending the reappointment of the current incumbents Cumpston, Silvey, and Zangari to fill the three (3) seats with full four-year terms ending March 1, 2027, and recommends appointing Ryan Carter to serve as an Alternate Member with term ending March 1, 2027.

Placerville Economic Advisory Committee:

Seven (7) applications were received for five (5) seats consisting of various membership representations and terms. One applicant did not meet the qualification criteria as stated in Municipal Code Section 1-9-9 and one applicant withdrew their application following their appointment to the Planning Commission.

The City Council Interview Sub-Committee chose not to conduct interviews and is recommending Council confirmation of the following appointments:

Mickey Kaiserman	At-large Representative	Term ending 3/1/2027

Paul Godwin	At-large Representative	Unexpired Term ending 3/1/2025

By approval of this item, the individuals appointed will be seated at their respective committee's next scheduled meeting.

1. The City Council could choose to re-open the application period for either of the two committees.


