A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE APPROVING A \$733,740 BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FUNDS AND AN \$800,000 BUDGET APPROPRIATION IN URBAN SURFACE TRANSPORTATION BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FUNDS FOR THE BROADWAY SIDEWALKS PROJECT (CIP #41606); APPROVING A CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DEWBERRY ENGINEERS, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT AND INSPECTION SERVICES IN THE AMOUNT OF \$331,655.80 FOR THE SAID PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME; APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 8 TO THE AGREEMENT WITH R.E.Y. ENGINEERS, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$26,527 FOR THE SAID PROJECT, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME; AUTHORIZING ISSUANCE OF NOTICE TO PROCEED #10 TO R.E.Y. ENGINEERS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION ENGINEERING PHASE FOR THE SAID PROJECT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$45,927; AND AUTHORIZING THE ENGINEERING DEPARTMENT TO RELEASE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT DOCUMENTS FOR PUBLIC BIDDING

WHEREAS, the City established Capital Improvement Project (CIP) #41606 to improve the sidewalks on Broadway from Mosquito Road to Orchard Lane; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on May 8, 2018, the City Council approved a Consultant Services Agreement with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$119,844 and authorized Notice to Proceed #1 for Phase I – Preliminary Engineering in an amount not-to-exceed \$59,630; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on January 22, 2019, the City Council approved a scope change Amendment No. 1 to the Consultant Services Agreement with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$119,844 and authorized Notice to Proceed #2 in an amount not-to-exceed \$29,222; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on February 26, 2019, the City Council approved Amendment No. 2 with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$29,222 and Notices to Proceed Nos. 3 and 4 totaling \$52,406; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on March 26, 2019, the City Council approved Amendment No. 3 and Notice to Proceed No. 5 with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$32,917; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on November 12, 2019, the City Council approved Amendment No. 4 with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$51,456; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on October 27, 2020, the City Council approved Amendment No. 5 with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$24,537; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on March 22, 2022, the City Council approved Amendment No. 6 with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$167,393; and

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WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on August 23, 2022, the City Council approved Amendment No. 7 with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in an amount not to exceed \$109,976; and

WHEREAS, the environmental, design, utility coordination, and right-of-way phases of the project are complete and the project funding has been obligated and authorized through funding oversight with Caltrans to allow the project to proceed to construction related activities and contracts; and

WHEREAS, the City received the authorization to proceed for all construction related activities from Caltrans Headquarters operating as the oversight agency for the project funding and is now ready to move the project forward into construction:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby

1. Approve a \$733,740 budget appropriation in Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP) funds for the Broadway Sidewalks project (CIP #41606); and
2. Approve an \$800,000 budget appropriation in Urban Surface Transportation Block Grant Program (STBGP) funds for the said project; and
3. Approve a Consulting Services Agreement with Dewberry Engineers Inc. for Construction Management and Inspection Services in the amount of \$331,655.80 for the said project, and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
4. Approve Amendment No. 8 to the Consulting to the Consulting Services Agreement with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. for additional construction engineering design services in the amount of \$26,527 for the said project, and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
5. Authorize the issuance of Notice to Proceed #10 to R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. for the construction engineering phase in the total amount of \$45,927 for the said project; and
6. Authorize the Engineering Department to release construction contract documents for public bidding.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on March 28, 2023, by Councilmember _____ who moved its
