A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE TO RECEIVE AND FILE A PROJECT STATUS UPDATE, RATIFY TASK ORDER NO. 1 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$25,000 AND APPROVE AMENDMENT #5 TO THE CONSULTANT SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH DEWBERRY ENGINEERS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$603,126.77, ISSUE NOTICE TO PROCEED #5 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$100,000 FOR INITIAL TASKS ASSOCIATED WITH THE ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT FOR THE CLAY STREET REALIGNMENT AND BRIDGE REPLACEMENT OVER HANGTOWN CREEK PROJECT (CIP #40617), AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME, AND APPROVING A \$125,000 BUDGET APPROPRIATION FROM THE TRAFFIC IMPACT MITIGATION FUND FOR THE SAID PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Clay Street Bridge Replacement project is a project to replace the functionally obsolete bridge over Hangtown Creek on Clay Street and realign Clay Street to intersect Main Street at the Cedar Ravine Road intersection; and

WHEREAS, at the regularly scheduled December 8, 2016 meeting, the Council approved a Consulting Services Agreement with Dewberry Engineers, Inc. (formerly Dewberry | Drake Haglan) for a total contract value of \$749,450 for engineering design services, EPA compliance, and bid document preparation; and

WHEREAS, at the regularly scheduled October 11, 2016 meeting, the Council approved Amendment #1 in an amount of \$14,618 for additional Environmental Documentation Services related to NEPA documentation for the project; and

WHEREAS, at the regularly scheduled October 10, 2017 meeting, the Council approved Amendment #2 to address additional federal contract requirements; and

WHEREAS, at the regularly scheduled May 8, 2018 meeting, the Council approved Amendment #3 in an amount of \$196,519.27 for additional environmental services; and

WHEREAS, at the regularly scheduled May 26, 2020 meeting, the Council approved Amendment #4 in an amount of \$65,708.22 for additional cultural resource consultation and documentation services; and

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WHEREAS, the contract with Michael Baker, Inc. contains tasks to complete the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) has expired, which has not been completed and is in need of significant updates to be in alignment with the additional cultural assessments that have been completed since initial circulation in 2018; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the project to shift the remaining tasks to complete the EIR to Dewberry Engineers, Inc. upon discovery that MBI has not retained any project history or institutional knowledge of the Clay Street Bridge Replacement Project internally with their staff; and

WHEREAS, the scope of services related to the EIR, including historic and cultural resource documentation for the Clay Street Realignment and Bridge Replacement Project has expanded and is already a part of the Dewberry Engineers, Inc. contract scope:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Receive and File status update for the Clay Street Realignment and Bridge Replacement project (CIP #40617); and
2. Ratify Task Order No. 1 in the amount of \$25,000 to Dewberry Engineers, Inc. for peer review of the Environmental Impact Report (EIR) for the said project; and
3. Approve Amendment #5 in a not to exceed amount of \$603,126.77 to the consulting services agreement with Dewberry Engineers, Inc. and authorizing Notice to Proceed #5 in the amount of \$100,000 for initial tasks related to the Environmental Impact Report for the said project; and
4. Authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
5. Approve a budget appropriation in the amount of \$125,000 from the Traffic Impact Mitigation (TIM) Fund for the said project.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on April 11, 2023, by Councilmember _____ who moved its
