**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
APPROVING AND ACCEPTING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE CALIFORNIA
OFFICE OF TRAFFIC SAFETY, SELECTIVE TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT PROGRAM
(STEP) GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$65,000.00, AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF
POLICE, POLICE SERGEANT, AND THE EXECUTIVE ASSISTANT TO THE CHIEF
OF POLICE TO EXECUTE THE SAME, AND APPROVING A BUDGET
APPROPRIATION FOR THE SAME AMOUNT**

WHEREAS, The City of Placerville City Council desires to undertake a certain project designated as Office of Traffic Safety, Selective Traffic Enforcement Program (STEP) to be funded through the Office of Traffic Safety, administered by Office of Traffic Safety (hereafter referred to as OTS); and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville accepts and approves an agreement with the California Office of Traffic Safety – Selective Traffic Enforcement Program Grant and authorizes the Chief of Police, Police Sergeant, and the Executive Assistant to the Chief of Police of the City of Placerville are authorized to execute on behalf of the City of Placerville City Council the attached contract, including any extensions or amendments thereof and any subsequent contract with the State in relation thereto; and

IT IS AGREED that any liability arising out of the performance of this contract, including civil court actions for damages, shall be the responsibility of the grant recipient and the authorizing agency. The State of California and OTS disclaim responsibility for any such liability; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that grant funds received hereunder shall not be used to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and

IT IS ALSO AGREED that this award is not subject to local firing freezes; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a \$65,000 budge appropriation is approved for the said Grant.
