**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PLACERVILLE AUTHORIZING A FIREWORKS DISPLAY AT THE
PLACERVILLE SPEEDWAY ON THE PLACERVILLE FAIRGROUND ON
SEPTEMBER 3, 2023**

WHEREAS, Russell Motorsports, Inc., in conjunction with Devastating Pyrotechnics desires to conduct a fireworks display on the 3rd of September, 2023 at the Placerville Speedway on the El Dorado County Fairgrounds property in the City of Placerville; and

WHEREAS, Title 3 Chapter 6 of the Placerville Municipal Code prohibits the sale or discharge of fireworks except as authorized by the City Council in full compliance with any conditions or restrictions applied by the El Dorado County Fire District; and

WHEREAS, the El Dorado County Fire District and the Placerville Police Department, shall have the right to revoke the permission to hold the display at any time due to extreme fire or other specific danger, up to and including when the display is to begin; and

WHEREAS, approval is contingent upon the obtainment of all authorizations and permits, obtainment of liability insurance, and/or obtainment of any permits required by the City of Placerville, and/or other agencies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby grants permission to conduct the requested firework display on Sunday, September 3, 2023, only, and provided that they comply fully with the aforementioned and any other additional requirements deemed necessary by fire control authorities.
