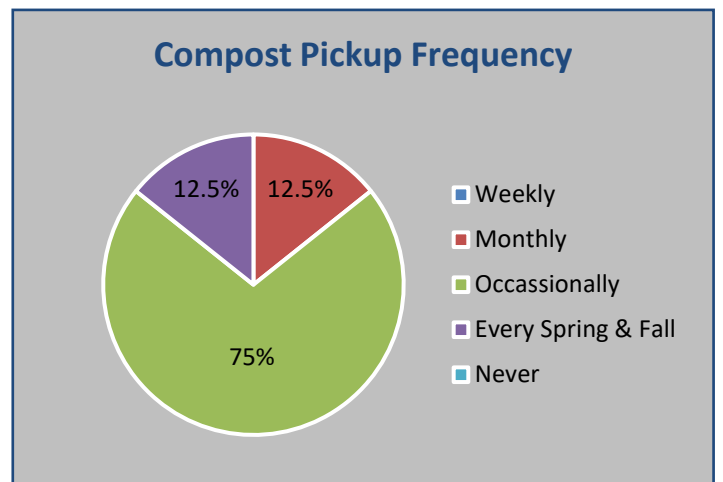
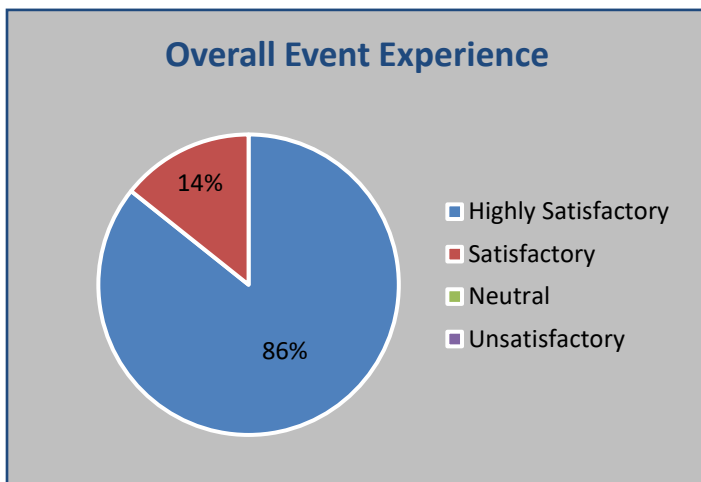
### COMMUNITY COMPOST EVENT ~ SATURDAY, OCTOBER 14, 2023

#### HIGHLIGHTS

- 100+ Residents attended the event.
- 20+ tons of compost was self-hauled on event day.
- 90 education bags were handed out.
- 4 education booths setup: El Dorado Disposal, Master Gardeners of El Dorado County, Placerville Garden Club, and El Dorado Beekeepers.

#### FEEDBACK

- **Suggestions:** Residents requested that shovels and a loader be available on event days to assist with the compost; Recommend a ticketing system (place in line) to pick up the compost.
- **Additional Education Topics:** Home Composting, Vermiculture Composting (Worms), Permaculture, and Food Preserving.

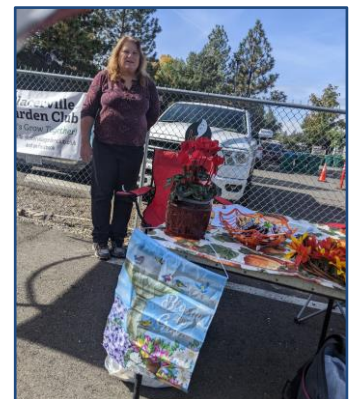
