**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF RIGHT-OF-WAY IN FEE TO EL DORADO
COUNTY TRANSIT AUTHORITY FOR THE RAY LAWYER DRIVE PARK-AND-
RIDE FACILITY CONSTRUCTED AS PART OF THE WESTERN PLACERVILLE
INTERCHANGES PHASE 2 PROJECT (CIP #41828) AND DIRECTING THE CITY
CLERK TO RECORD SAID CONVEYANCE WITH THE OFFICE OF THE EL
DORADO COUNTY RECORDER**

WHEREAS, on August 11, 2015, City Council authorized a cooperative with El Dorado County Transit Authority (EDCTA) for the design and construction of the EDCTA park-and-ride facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville has completed construction of the Western Placerville Interchanges Phase 2 Project (CIP #41828) and is now ready to finalize the right-of-way transaction needed to convey the right-of-way for the park-and-ride facility to El Dorado County Transit Authority.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

Authorize the conveyance of right-of-way in fee to El Dorado County Transit Authority for the Ray Lawyer Drive Park-and-Ride facility constructed with the Western Placerville Interchanges Phase 2 Project (CIP #41828) and direct the City Clerk to record said conveyance with the Office of the El Dorado County Recorder.
