A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE APPROVING BUDGET APPROPRIATIONS FROM THE MEASURE L FUND IN THE COMBINED AMOUNT OF \$1,500,000 AND FROM THE MEASURE H FUND IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,300,000, APPROVING BUDGET LIQUIDATIONS FROM THE ARPA FUND TOTALING \$412,175 AND APPROPRIATING THOSE FUNDS FOR THE BROADWAY MAINTENANCE PROJECT – FROM MOSQUITO ROAD TO SCHNELL SCHOOL ROAD (CIP #42003), REJECTING A BID PROTEST FROM B&M BUILDERS, INC.; APPROVING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH DOUG VEERKAMP GENERAL ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$4,926,039.80 AND APPROVING CONTRACT CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 IN THE COMBINED CREDIT AMOUNT OF \$914,414.86, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE CONTRACT CHANGE ORDERS UP TO \$25,000 PER CHANGE ORDER FOR AN AGGREGATE NOT-TO-EXCEED AMOUNT OF \$150,000 FOR THE SAID PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City established a Capital Improvement Project (CIP #42003) to address roadway and utility maintenance on Broadway from Mosquito Road to Schnell School Road; and

WHEREAS, on November 10, 2020, the City Council awarded a Consulting Services Agreement REY Engineers, Inc. for design services, and the construction contract documents for the Broadway Maintenance Project (CIP #42003) are complete; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on March 28, 2023, the City Council approved a Consultant Services Agreement with Dewberry Engineers Inc. for construction management and inspection services in the amount of \$254,107.30; and

WHEREAS, the City released construction documents for public bidding, and bids were publicly opened and read aloud on October 24, 2023, and is now ready to award a construction contract.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Approve a \$1,300,000 budget appropriation from the Measure L Construction Reserve for the Broadway Maintenance Project From Mosquito Road to Schnell School Road (CIP #42003); and
2. Approve a \$200,000 budget appropriation from the Measure L fund unassigned fund balance for the said project; and
3. Approve a \$1,300,000 budget appropriation from the Measure H Fund Construction Reserve for the said project; and
4. Approve a \$141,370 budget liquidation from the ARPA Fund for the Fuel Reduction Treatment for City Property Project (CIP #42241); and
5. Approve a \$63,000 budget liquidation from the ARPA Fund for the Lions Park Large Shelter Project (CIP #42303); and

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6. Approve a \$207,805 budget liquidation from the ARPA Fund for the contribution to El Dorado County for the Homeless Navigation Center; and
7. Approve a \$412,175 budget appropriation from the ARPA Fund for the Broadway Maintenance Project From Mosquito Road to Schnell School Road (CIP #42003); and
8. Reject the bid protest received from B&M Builders Inc.; and
9. Approve a Construction Contract with the lowest responsive bidder, Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc., in an amount not to exceed \$4,926,039.80 for the said project, and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
10. Approve Construction Contract Change Order No. 1 with Doug Veerkamp General Engineering Inc. in the combined credit amount of \$914,414.86 for the said project, and authorizing the City Manager to execute the same; and
11. Authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute any necessary Contract Change Orders with Doug Veerkamp General Engineering, Inc. up to \$25,000 per change for a not-to-exceed aggregate amount of \$150,000 for the said project. Said change orders shall be brought to the next available City Council meeting for either approval or ratification.
