Subject: Review of the draft Private Sewer Lateral Informational Handout and the draft Certificate of Lateral Compliance.

Recommendation: Receive and file the report and provide staff with any comments.

Purpose: To provide the City Council and the public with an opportunity to review and comment on the draft Private Sewer Lateral Informational Handout and the draft Certificate of Lateral Compliance.

Background: On December 12, 2023, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 1712 amending Title 7 of the Placerville Municipal Code *Health and Sanitation* adding Chapter 17 *Private Sewer Lateral Ordinance*. The purpose of this Ordinance is to regulate private sewer laterals to protect the health and safety of the public by reducing or eliminating the discharge of sewage into the environment; and to reduce or eliminate sources of inflow and infiltration (I&I) into the City's sewer system in compliance with the City's sanitary sewer system state permit.

The Ordinance became effective on January 11, 2024.

Discussion: Following its adoption, the Council requested that staff create a handout that can be provided to the public and interested parties regarding the implementation of the Ordinance.

Attached are the draft Private Sewer Lateral Informational Handout and the draft Certificate of Lateral Compliance for review. The draft documents are a work in progress and staff encourages any suggested revisions, in particular the Informational Handout, to improve the usefulness of the documents.
