**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE  
APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE CONSULTING SERVICES  
AGREEMENT WITH R.E.Y. ENGINEERS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF -\$59,210 FOR  
THE PLACERVILLE DRIVE PEDESTRIAN CONNECTIVITY PROJECT (CIP#42337),  
AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME**

**WHEREAS**, at its regular meeting held on May 24, 2022, the City Council authorized staff to pursue funding for projects eligible for the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) program, and the Placerville Drive Pedestrian Connectivity Project was successful, thereby establishing Capital Improvement Project (CIP) #42337; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 24, 2023, the City Council approved a Consulting Services Agreement with R.E.Y. Engineers, Inc. in the amount of \$529,154, and issuance of Notice to Proceed #1 in the amount of \$269,048; and

**WHEREAS**, the Right-of-Way Engineering services included in the Agreement will be significantly reduced due to recent discoveries in the project mapping:

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby approve Amendment No. 1 to the Consulting Services Agreement with R.E.Y. Engineers Inc. in the amount of -\$59,210 Placerville Drive Pedestrian Connectivity project (CIP #42337) and authorize the City Manager to execute the same.
