A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE APPROVING A CONSULTING SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH ROBERTSON-BRYAN, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$44,228 FOR THE Fiscal Year 2024/2025 SERVICES RELATED TO THE NPDES PERMIT FOR THE WATER RECLAMATION FACILITY, AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME

WHEREAS, the City's wastewater treatment plant, known as the Water Reclamation Facility (WRF), is regulated by a National Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) permit issued by the Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board which governs the discharge requirements of the plant; and

WHEREAS, Robertson-Bryan, Inc. (RBI) has intimate knowledge of the WRF plant operations having assisted the City with the HCWRF permit since 1998 and is uniquely qualified to perform this work; and

WHEREAS, RBI is on the City's Qualified Consultant List, approved by the City Council on November 14, 2023; and

WHEREAS, the scope of work and fee schedule prepared by RBI meets the needs of the City, and staff is recommending approval of a Consulting Services Agreement with RBI for FY 24/25:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby approve a Consulting Services Agreement with Robertson-Bryan, Inc. (RBI) in an amount not to exceed \$44,228.00 for the Fiscal Year 2024/2025 services related to the NPDES permit for the Water Reclamation Facility and authorize the City Manager to execute the same.
