A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF ONE DOUBLE STATION TRASH/RECYCLE RECEPTACLES FROM BIGBELLY FOR PLACEMENT WITHIN CITY RIGHT-OF-WAY FOR AN APPROXIMATE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$6,323.64; APPROVING A \$5,000 BUDGET APPROPRIATION FOR THE SAID RECEPTACLES; AND APPROVING THE ACCEPTANCE OF A CONTRIBUTION FROM EL DORADO DISPOSAL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1,323.64 FOR PURCHASE OF THE SAME

WHEREAS, the City receives \$5,000 annually from the Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery's (CalRecycle) Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program to fund eligible activities specifically for beverage container recycling and litter cleanup activities; and

WHEREAS, the City is in receipt of funding from CalRecycle in the amount of \$5,000 for the Fiscal Year 2023-24; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to utilize these funds for the purchase of one double station trash/recycle receptacles from Bigbelly to be placed within the City right-of-way; and

WHEREAS, the total cost of the trash/recycle receptacles including sales tax and shipping totals approximately \$6,323.64 which is above the \$5,000 available funding the City has received from CalRecycle, and with the remaining balance of approximately \$1,323.64 will be funded by a contribution from El Dorado Disposal for participation in the pilot program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council approves the contribution of \$1,232.64 from El Dorado Disposal for the purchase of the trash/recycle receptacles; and

WHEREAS, the purchase of the Bigbelly double station trash/recycle receptacles is an eligible purchase under CalRecycle's the Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Approving the purchase of a double station trash/recycle receptacles from Bigbelly for a total amount of \$6,323.64 for placement within City public right-of-way;
2. Approving a \$5,000 budget appropriation in FY 2023/2024 CalRecycle Beverage Container Recycling City/County Payment Program funds for the said trash/recycle receptacles and litter cleanup; and
3. Approving the acceptance of a contribution in the amount of \$1,323.64 from El Dorado Disposal for purchase of the same.
