**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
 APPROVING A FUNDING/REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH EL DORADO
 COUNTY TOTALING \$20,300.00, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK
 TO EXECUTE THE SAME, AND APPROVING A \$20,300 BUDGET APPROPRIATION
 FOR THE PURCHASE OF BALLISTIC HELMETS AND COMMUNICATION
 HEADSETS UNDER THE FISCAL YEAR 2023 HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT
 PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, the City of Placerville has been awarded \$20,300.00 in the Fiscal Year 2023 Homeland Security Grant Funding to purchase ballistic helmets and communication headsets; and

WHEREAS, the requirements to fund the purchase require the City to enter into a Reimbursement Agreement with the County of El Dorado; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to purchase 20 ballistic helmets from Hard Head Veterans and 20 communication headsets from Sorid, the lowest of the three quotes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby approve a Fiscal Year 2023 Homeland Security Grant funding/reimbursement agreement with El Dorado County not to exceed \$20,300.00 for 20 ballistic helmets and 20 communication headsets for the Police Department, and authorize the Mayor and City Clerk to execute the same, and approve a \$20,300 budget appropriation for the said Grant.
