**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
 APPROVING AN 1.60% INCREASE TO THE CITY'S TRAFFIC IMPACT
 MITIGATION (TIM) FEES EQUIVALENT TO THE ANNUAL CHANGE IN THE
 ENGINEERING NEWS RECORD CONSTRUCTION COST INDEX FROM JANUARY
 2024 TO JANUARY 2025, EFFECTIVE APRIL 14, 2025**

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2008, the City Council adopted a resolution establishing the Interim Traffic Impact Mitigation Fees which went into effect December 13, 2008 and remains in effect; and

WHEREAS, the TIM Ordinance allows for a regular inflation update to said mitigation fees based on the change in the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index in accordance with City Code Section 8-15-5; and

WHEREAS, the Interim TIM Fees were last increased for inflation on April 27, 2024 to account for inflation from December 2021 through January 2024; and

WHEREAS, the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index has increased by 1.60% from January 2024 to January 2025; and

WHEREAS, staff has calculated new fees reflecting said inflationary increase as outlined in the attached Exhibit "A", including the per trip unit fees described below the table as in the existing code section; and

WHEREAS, notice of the time and place of the meeting, including a general explanation of the matter to be considered, was published in the Mountain Democrat, a newspaper of general circulation, on January 29, 2025 and again on January 31, 2025, in accordance with Government Code Section 6062a; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2025 the City Council held a public meeting in compliance with Government Code Sections 66016(a) and 66018 where all interested parties were able to provide testimony.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

Approve an 1.60% increase in the Traffic Impact Mitigation (TIM) Fees equivalent to the change in the Engineering News Record Construction Cost Index from January 2024 to January 2025, effective April 14, 2025, as shown in Exhibit "A."

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on February 11, 2025 by Councilmember _____ who
