**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
PLACERVILLE REQUESTING \$115,245 IN FINANCIAL COMMITMENT
FROM EL DORADO COUNTY FOR THE 2025/2026 FISCAL YEAR TO
SUPPORT MAINTENANCE COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH PROVIDING A
COMPREHENSIVE PROGRAM AT THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE AQUATICS
CENTER**

WHEREAS, the City and El Dorado County continue to work together for the benefit of our entire community throughout the County; and

WHEREAS, in the past the El Dorado County Board of Supervisors has been sympathetic to the fact that approximately 76% of the people who utilize the City Aquatics Center reside outside the City limits; and

WHEREAS, the City has an opportunity to request essential funding from El Dorado County to help with the maintenance costs associated with providing a vital and comprehensive aquatics program:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville adopt a resolution requesting \$115,245 in financial assistance from El Dorado County for the 2025/2026 fiscal year to help offset some of the operational costs associated with providing a comprehensive program at the City Aquatics Center.
