Subject: Acknowledge the Appointments to the Planning Commission and Recreation & Parks Commission by the City Council and Confirm the Interview Sub-Committee's Recommended Appointments to the Measures H & L Sales Tax Committee and the Placerville Economic Advisory Committee

Purpose: The purpose of this item is to facilitate the appointments and seating of public members on the City's Commissions and Committees.

Strategic Plan Strategy: N/A

Background: Every two years, the City accepts applications from the public to serve on City commissions and committees with upcoming term expirations or vacancies. The full City Council interviews Commission applicants in a public forum. The Interview Sub-Committee is established by the Mayor to interview Committee applicants in a non-public setting.

In January of this year, Vice-Mayor Gotberg and Councilmember Yarbrough were appointed by Mayor Clerici to serve on the City Council Interview Sub-Committee for the purpose of interviewing Committee applicants and making their recommendations for appointments at a regularly scheduled City Council meeting.

Discussion:

Planning Commission and Recreation & Parks Commission

A Special Meeting of the City Council was held on March 5, 2025 for the purpose of interviewing applicants for the City's commissions. Six applicants were interviewed in a group setting for each commission. At the conclusion of the interviews, the City Council voted and made the following appointments:

Planning Commission (two full four-year terms ending March 1, 2029):

Catherine Silvester

Alyssa Stratton

Recreation & Parks Commission (two full four-year terms ending March 1, 2029)

Andre Pichly

Michael Potter (incumbent)

Measures H and L Sales Tax Committee

Only two applications were received for the two vacancies on the Measures H & L Sales Tax Committee, which were submitted by current incumbents, Mickey Kaiserman and Sue Rodman.

The Interview Sub-Committee chose not to hold interviews for these two seats and is recommending the reappointment of Mickey Kaiserman and Sue Rodman to fill the two seats with full four-year terms ending March 1, 2029.

Placerville Economic Advisory Committee:

Three vacancies were announced consisting of one (1) Chamber of Commerce, (1) Broadway Business Area, and (1) Member At-large representative with terms ending 3/1/2029.

Two applications were received; one from incumbent Adam Anderson (for Chamber representation) and one from Kathi Lishman (for Member At-large representation). No applications were received for the Broadway Business Area representative.

The City Council Interview Sub-Committee chose not to conduct interviews and is recommending Council confirmation of the following appointments:

Adam Anderson	Chamber of Commerce Representative	Term ending 3/1/2029
Kathi Lishman	At-large Representative	Term ending 3/1/2029

Staff is recommending that the application period for the Broadway Business Area Representative remain open until a qualified applicant can be established.

By approval of this item, the individuals appointed will be seated at their respective committee's next scheduled meeting.

1. The City Council could choose to re-open the application period for either of the two committees.
