**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
APPROVING A \$4.20 PER GAME INCREASE IN THE ADULT SOFTBALL
TEAM REGISTRATION FEE AND AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
COMMUNITY SERVICES TO NEGOTIATE A THREE-YEAR AGREEMENT
WITH THE GREATER SACRAMENTO SOFTBALL ASSOCIATION FOR
ADULT SOFTBALL OFFICIATING SERVICES**

WHEREAS, the Community Services Department operates an Adult Softball League at Lions Park, offering Spring/Summer and Fall leagues, each consisting of a 10-week season including playoffs; and

WHEREAS, the Folsom Officials Association, which previously provided officiating services for the City's Adult Softball League for over 20 years, has provided notice of retirement and will no longer operate as an Officials Association; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to enter into a three-year agreement with GSSA, effective May 1, 2025, through December 31, 2027, and

WHEREAS, the increased costs of officiating services under the GSSA agreement will result in an estimated annual expense of \$21,486.00 for the 2025 season; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to increase the per game Adult Softball team registration fee by \$4.20 in order to cover the increased costs of officiating services and the State minimum wage; and

WHEREAS, this fee increase aligns with the City's Strategic Plan Strategy for Fiscal Stability/Sustainability, to increase revenue and maintain a sustainable program:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Placerville City Council does hereby:

1. Authorize the Director of Community Services to negotiate and execute a three-year agreement with GSSA for softball officiating services from May 1, 2025, to December 31, 2027; and
2. Approve a \$4.20 per game increase in the Adult Softball team registration fee for a 10-week season for a total fee of \$776.00 per team effective June 23, 2025.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on April 8, 2025, by Councilmember _____ who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Councilmember _____.
