**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
APPROVING A RESERVATION AGREEMENT WITH WESTERVELT ECOLOGICAL
SERVICES, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$477,000 FOR THE WESTERN
PLACERVILLE INTERCHANGE, PHASE 2 PROJECT (CIP #41828), AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME, AND
APPROVING A \$400,000 BUDGET APPROPRIATION FROM THE TRAFFIC IMPACT
MITIGATION FEE FUND FOR THE SAID PROJECT**

WHEREAS, The Western Placerville Interchange, Phase 2 project constructed the eastbound off-ramp at Ray Lawyer Drive from US Highway 50, intersection improvements at Ray Layer Drive/Forni Road, improvements to and the realignment of Forni Road, and a park-and-ride facility; and

WHEREAS, Construction concluded on July 14, 2020 and the City filed Notice of Completion; and

WHEREAS, compensatory environmental mitigation is required of the project due to permanent riparian impacts in accordance with the project's Streambed Alteration Agreement issued by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) in 2017:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby

1. Approve a Reservation Agreement with Westervelt Ecological Services, LLC for the Purchase and Sale of Mitigation Credits from Johnson Consumnes Mitigation Bank in the amount of \$477,000 for the Western Placerville Interchange, Phase 2 project (CIP #41828) and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
2. Approve a budget appropriation in the amount of \$400,000 from the Traffic Impact Mitigation Fee Fund for the said project
