A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
APPROVING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 WITH PROUD CONSTRUCTION IN
THE AMOUNT OF \$8,459.12 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER
TO EXECUTE THE SAME FOR THE DOWNTOWN PUBLIC RESTROOM
RENOVATION PROJECT (CIP #42418) AND APPROVING A \$4,000 BUDGET
APPROPRIATION FOR THE SAID PROJECT

WHEREAS, the City's Capital Improvement Program (CIP) for Fiscal Year 2023-2024 prioritized the renovation of the Downtown Public Restroom (CIP #42418) to address outdated infrastructure, ensure compliance with Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards, and meet health and safety requirements; and

WHEREAS, Proud Construction, completed the renovation, including new fixtures, stalls, Fast Aire hand dryers, vandal-resistant partitions, FRP, coving, tiles, floor drains, skylights, gate repairs, epoxy flooring, and electrical upgrades with a Nema 3R panel, conduit, circuits, wall packs, and outdoor lighting; and

WHEREAS, a change order No. 1 not exceeding \$8,459.12 is needed for additional work (FRP, coving, and tiles at \$2,712.54; upgraded hand dryer at \$1,059.08 after \$880.00 credit; electrical upgrades at \$4,687.50), increasing the project cost from \$65,450 to \$78,459.12; and

WHEREAS, these actions align with the City's strategic plan to improve public facilities, ensuring ADA compliance, reduced maintenance costs, and enhanced community spaces.

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to approve contract change order No. 1 with Proud Construction in the amount of \$8,459.12.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville hereby:

1. Approve a contract change order No. 1 with Proud Construction in an amount not to exceed \$8,459.12 for the Downtown Public Restrooms Renovation project (CIP #42418) and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
2. Approve a \$4,000 budget appropriation from the General Fund Contingency for Unforeseen Expenditures for the said project.

The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on June 10, 2025 by Councilmember _____ who moved its adoption.
