Re: Fireworks Special Use Permit - 4th of July Ariel Low Level Electric Display

Mr. Morris,

Russell Motorsports, Inc. is requesting permission from El Dorado County Fire to conduct a public firework display on Thursday July 4, 2025. This will take place at the Placerville Speedway located on the El Dorado County Fairgrounds property. The display will take place at nightfall, approximately 9:30pm, and will be put on this year by Devastating Pyrotechnics, Inc. This year's display will essentially be the same size and scope as those of the previous years.

The El Dorado County Fire Protection District's Prevention Bureau has reviewed and approved the permit application to ensure that this public firework display conforms to all current CFC Chapter 56, California State Fire Marshal regulations, NFPA 1123, 1124 and Title 19 California Administrative Code. Issues related to public safety, traffic, parking, security, and radio communications will be addressed by the City of Placerville in the same manner as in previous years.

For City Council consideration, Russel Motorsports, in conjunction with Devastating Pyrotechnics, Inc. has met the required Special Permit process through El Dorado County Fire. In accordance with City Code Title 3, Chapter 6 Russell Motorsports will need City of Placerville approval.
