**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
SELECTING ADVANCED STREAM BROADBAND AND SUMOFIBER AS THE
INAUGURAL INTERNET SERVICE PROVIDERS (ISP) FOR THE INITIAL
LAUNCH OF THE CITY'S BROADBAND FIBER NETWORK (PLACERVILLE
FIBER) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO NEGOTIATE AND
EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE
PROVIDERS
(CIP #42340)**

WHEREAS, the City Council approved a Master Services Agreement with EntryPoint Networks, Inc. on October 22, 2024, for consulting services to develop the City's Broadband Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the California Public Utility Commission awarded a \$20,198,943 Last Mile Federal Funding Account Grant (Resolution T-17845); and

WHEREAS, the City Council now desires to enter into a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with Advanced Stream Broadband and Sumofiber as the Initial Internet Service Providers for the project; and

WHEREAS, Advanced Stream Broadband and Sumofiber have demonstrated the technical expertise and experience to provide the service .

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Select Advanced Stream Broadband and Sumofiber as the inaugural internet service providers for the City's Broadband Fiber Project (CIP #42340); and
2. Authorize the City Manager to negotiate and execute a Memorandum of Understanding with Advanced Stream Broadband and Sumofiber to provide Internet Service for the City's Broadband Fiber project (CIP #42340).
