

RESOLUTION NO. ____**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
RETROACTIVELY APPROVING AND AFFIRMING A SALARY SCHEDULE
EFFECTIVE JULY 5, 2025**

WHEREAS, at its meeting held on March 11, 2025, the City Council ratified the Tentative Agreement (TA) with the International Union of Operating Engineers Stationary Engineers, Local 39 (Local 39) unit for the period of January 1, 2025 to December 31, 2026 in Closed Session, and the City Attorney reported out the TA in Open Session that same evening; and

WHEREAS, one of the deal points of the TA with Local 39 is a 1.00% Cost of Living Adjustment (COLA) salary increase effective the first full pay period in July 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide the same 1.00% COLA for all regular non-sworn positions within the Confidential Unit, Executive Management Unit, and the Supervisory Unit, which are unrepresented, effective the first full pay period in July 2025; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held on June 10, 2025, the City Council ratified the TA with the Placerville Police Officers Association (PPOA) unit for the period of July 1, 2025 to June 30, 2028 in Closed Session, and the City Attorney reported out the TA in Open Session that same evening; and

WHEREAS, one of the deal points of the TA with the PPOA is a 2.00% COLA effective the first full pay period in July 2025; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to provide the same 2.00% COLA for all regular sworn positions within the Executive Management Unit, which is unrepresented, effective the first full pay period in July 2025; and

WHEREAS, Staff has prepared a new salary schedule that incorporates the said COLAs for the affected positions:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville retroactively approves and affirms the salary schedule effective July 5, 2025 (Attachment "A").
