**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE CONSULTING SERVICES
AGREEMENT WITH ROBERTSON-BRYAN, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED
\$32,017 FOR SERVICES THROUGH JUNE 30, 2026 FOR THE CITY'S SMALL
MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEM (MS4) PERMIT, AND
AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME AND APPROVING
AN \$18,017 BUDGET APPROPRIATION FROM THE GENERAL FUND UNASSIGNED
FUND BALANCE FOR THE SAID AMENDMENT NO. 1**

WHEREAS, the City's storm drainage system is regulated by the State Water Resources Control Board Order No. 2013-0001-DWQ Waste Discharge Requirements for Storm Water Discharges from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer Systems (MS4); and

WHEREAS, Robertson-Bryan, Inc. (RBI) has intimate knowledge of the Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit requirements, is uniquely qualified to perform this work and has submitted proposals acceptable to the City that would provide the technical support necessary for compliance with this permit for a total cost of \$14,745; and

WHEREAS, on November 12, 2024, the City Council approved a Consulting Services Agreement with RBI to perform MS4 permitting services for Fiscal Year 2024/2025; and

WHEREAS, an amendment is needed to continue these services through Fiscal Year 2025/2026.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Approve Amendment No. 1 to the Consulting Services Agreement with Robertson-Bryan, Inc. in an amount not-to-exceed \$32,017 for services through June 30, 2026 for the City's Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Permit and authorizing the City Manager to execute the same; and
2. Approve an \$18,017 budget appropriation from the General Fund unassigned fund balance for the said Amendment No. 1.
