A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE APPROVING A REQUEST FOR LOCAL ADVANCE CONSTRUCTION AUTHORIZATION FOR THE PLACERVILLE DRIVE BRIDGE REPLACEMENT PROJECT (CIP #41410) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME

WHEREAS, City has identified the need to replace the functionally obsolete bridge on Placerville Drive at Hangtown Creek; and

WHEREAS, the Placerville Drive at Hangtown Creek Bridge Replacement Project (CIP No. 41410) located 0.3 miles west of Cold Springs Road is a project initiated in 1997 to replace the existing narrow, substandard existing structure using Federal Highway Bridge Program (HBP) funds in combination with a local funding match; and

WHEREAS, due to utility relocation delays and in accordance with the Local Assistance Program Guidelines (LAPG) for the Highway Bridge Program, the project’s funding for construction has been moved out to the last year of the FSTIP, which is Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) 27/28; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to request Local Advance Construction in FFY 25/26 to allow the project to move forward to the Construction phase in the same timeline as the Placerville Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Project (CIP #41816) to ensure successful construction of both projects concurrently.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby approve a Request for Local Advance Construction Authorization for the Placerville Drive Bridge Replacement Project (CIP #41410) and authorize the City Manager to execute the same.
