OF CALIFORNIA STATEHOOD**

**WHEREAS**, on September 9, 1850, California was officially admitted to the Union as the 31st state, launching a rich and complex history of innovation, diversity, and progress that continues to shape our nation; and

**WHEREAS**, in the 175 years since statehood, California has become a global leader in agriculture, science, arts, environmental leadership, technology, and civil rights- and our own community of the City of Placerville has proudly contributed to that story; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Placerville joins communities across the Golden State in honoring this historic milestone and recognizing the shared values that unite us as Californians; and

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it resolved that I, John Clerici, Mayor of the City of Placerville on behalf of the City Council and the people of our city, do hereby proclaim September 9, 2025, as

**“California’s 175<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of Statehood”**

and encourage all residents to take part in commemorating this momentous occasion through community events, civic engagement, and reflection on our shared heritage and future.
