

**RESOLUTION NO. \_\_\_\_****A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE  
RATIFYING BUILDING CODE AMENDMENTS TO THE 2022 CALIFORNIA FIRE  
CODE ADOPTED BY THE EL DORADO COUNTY FIRE PROTECTION DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 9, the California Fire Code, is updated by the State every three years; and

**WHEREAS**, the 2025 California Fire Code will become effective on January 1, 2026; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Placerville has adopted the California Code of Regulations, Title 24, Part 9 know as the California Fire Code; as codified under City Code Section 4-1-4; and

**WHEREAS**, California Health and Safety Code Sections 17958, 17958.5, 17958.7, and 18941.5 permits a city to make such local amendments and modifications as the City determines are reasonably necessary because of local climatic, geological, and/or topographical conditions; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Health and Safety Code, Section 13869.7 requires the legislative body of the city or county where the ordinance will apply to ratify, modify, or deny the adopted Ordinance; and

**WHEREAS**, the California Code of Regulations, Health and Safety Code, Division 12, Part 2, Chapter 1, Article 2, Section 13146, assigns responsibility or enforcement of fire safety regulations to the local level and grants authority to the City to delegate enforcement to the chief building official, or his or her authorized representative, or the chief of the fire protection district, or his or her representative; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Placerville entered into an agreement: “Reorganization of the City of Placerville Fire Department, Placerville Fire Protection District, Pollock Pines/Camino Fire Protection District, the Shingle Springs Fire Protection District, and the Pleasant Valley Fire Protection District” on November 13, 1990; and the El Dorado County Fire Protection District provides fire protection and prevention services to the City pursuant to said agreement; and

**WHEREAS**, on August 21, 2025, the Board of Directors of the El Dorado County Fire Protection District adopted Resolution 2025-10 that adopted findings supporting amendment to the California Fire Code deemed necessary because of local climate, geological, and/or topographical conditions; and on September 18 said Board adopted Ordinance No. 2025-01 adopting the 2025 Edition of the California Fire Code with the amendments made under Section 3 of said Ordinance:

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby ratify the building code amendments to the California Fire Code adopted by the El Dorado County Fire Protection District on September 18, 2025, Ordinance No. 2025-01, attached hereto as Exhibit A; and delegates enforcement of said code to the Fire Chief or his or her representative.
