**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
APPROVING A CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT WITH C.E. COX GENERAL
ENGINEERING, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$31,818 FOR SIDEWALK REPAIRS
PROJECT (CIP #42612), FOR BEDFORD AVENUE CURB RAMP AND MAIN STREET
SIDEWALK AND AUTHORIZE THE CITY MANAGER TO EXECUTE THE SAME;
APPROVING A \$40,000 BUDGET APPROPRIATION FROM THE ROAD
MAINTENANCE AND REHABILITATION ACCOUNT FOR THE SAID PROJECT,
AND FINDING THE PROJECT IS EXEMPT FROM CEQA**

WHEREAS, the Sidewalk Repairs project (CIP#42612) for Bedford Avenue Curb Ramp and Main Street Sidewalk was not included in the Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Capital Improvement Program Budget; and

WHEREAS, On July 5, 2022 and August 7, 2025, the City received an Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) grievance from a resident concerning the lack of an ADA-compliant curb ramp on the west side of the crosswalk on Bedford Avenue; and

WHEREAS, adjacent to 459 Main Street, a City street tree has been heaving the adjacent sidewalk and curb and gutter creating a tripping hazard in the sidewalk; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to construct a curb ramp at the Bedford Avenue crosswalk to address the ADA grievance and repair the curb, gutter, and sidewalk section on Main Street; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Public Contract Code 22032, staff negotiated the scope of work and cost of construction, and the contractor then prepared a time-and-materials estimate for the repairs; and

WHEREAS, The project is determined to be Categorical Exempt according to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301(c) because the project involves the repair and maintenance of existing sidewalk, and a Notice of Exemption was filed on November 4, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Approve a construction contract with C.E. Cox General Engineering, Inc. for the Sidewalk Repairs project (CIP #42612) for Bedford Avenue Curb Ramp and Main Street Sidewalk in an amount not to exceed \$31,818; and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
2. Approve a \$40,000 budget appropriation from the Road Maintenance and Rehabilitation Account for the said project; and
3. Find the project is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Section 15301 (c).

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The foregoing Resolution was introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the City of Placerville held on November 12, 2025 by Councilmember _____ who moved its adoption.
