Subject: Consider appointing Mica Raas as the Member at Large to the Placerville Economic Advisory Committee effective immediately with a term ending March 1, 2027.

Recommendation:

Approve the appointment of Mica Raas as the Member at Large to the Placerville Economic Advisory Committee (PEAC) effective immediately with a term ending March 1, 2027.

Purpose:

To fill the vacant Member at Large seat to the PEAC that was previously held by Debbie Miller.

Background:

The PEAC is comprised of the following seven seats:

 Patty Borelli: Placerville Drive Business Area Representative (03/01/27 term expiration)
 Mickey Kaiserman: Member at Large (03/01/27 term expiration)
 Kathi Lishman: Member at Large (03/01/29 term expiration)
 Tony Windle: Downtown Business Representative (03/01/27 term expiration)
 Vacant: Broadway Area Business Representative (03/01/29 term expiration)
 Vacant: Member at Large (03/01/27 term expiration)

The Broadway Area Business Representative seat was vacated with the resignation of David Thomas, and the Member at Large seat was vacated when past Chair, Debbie Miller, resigned last month

Discussion:

Staff has recruited for both vacant seats and received an application from Mica Raas for the Member at Large seat. Last Friday, the City Council Sub-Committee Interview Team, which is comprised of Vice-Mayor Gotberg and Councilmember Yarbrough, interviewed Mr. Raas and unanimously recommended that he be appointed as the new Member at Large by the entire City Council. As an introduction, Mr. Raas lives in the City of Placerville and is a local entrepreneur who has owned and operated a successful business in El Dorado County.

Options:

1. Approve the City Council Sub-Committee Interview Team's recommendation.
2. Direct staff to continue recruiting for the Member at Large seat.

3. Take no action.
