**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PLACERVILLE
 APPROVING AMENDMENT NO. 12 TO THE CONSULTING SERVICES
 AGREEMENT WITH DEWBERRY ENGINEERS INC. AND ISSUANCE OF NOTICE
 TO PROCEED #11, APPROVING A DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION
 RESPONSIBILITY AND REIMBURSEMENT AGREEMENT WITH EL DORADO
 IRRIGATION DISTRICT (EID), AND APPROVING A BUDGET APPROPRIATION
 FROM EID ALL IN THE AMOUNT OF \$19,000 FOR THE PLACERVILLE DRIVE
 BICYCLE AND PEDESTRIAN FACILITIES PROJECT (CIP #41816)**

WHEREAS, on June 27, 2017, the City Council approved the Fiscal Year 2017-2018 CIP Budget establishing CIP project (#41816) to provide new bicycle and pedestrian facilities on Placerville Drive from Armory Drive to the Highway 50 undercrossing, and a new sidewalk on Green Valley Road from Placerville Drive to Mallard Lane; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on July 10, 2018, the City Council approved a Consultant Services Agreement with Dewberry Engineers Inc. for CIP #41410 and CIP #41816, with \$1,266,429.75 for CIP #41816, and issuance of Notice to Proceed #1 for the Project Approval and Environmental Documentation phase in a total amount not to exceed \$820,681.81; and

WHEREAS, at its regular meeting held on April 23, 2019, the City Council approved no-cost Amendment No. 1 with Dewberry Engineers Inc. for CIP #41816, and issuance of Notice to Proceed #2 to Dewberry in an amount not to exceed \$25,173; and

WHEREAS, on February 11, 2020, the City Council approved no-cost Amendment No. 2 with Dewberry Engineers Inc. for CIP #41816, and issuance of Notice to Proceed #3 to Dewberry in an amount not to exceed \$35,760.83; and

WHEREAS, on January 10, 2023 the City Council approved Amendment No. 4 in the amount of \$1,769,939.30 and issuance of Notice to Proceed #4 to Dewberry in the amount of \$641,375 to begin the final design phase for CIP #41816; and

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2023, the City Council authorized issuance of Notice to Proceed #5 in the amount of \$200,000 to Dewberry Engineers to begin the right-of-way phase; and

WHEREAS, on August 8, 2023, the City Council approved the issuance of Notice to Proceed #6 in the amount of \$1,313,378.38 for final design and right-of-way engineering services; and

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2023 the City Council approved Amendment No. 5 and issuance of Notice to Proceed #7 in the amount of \$129,234.91 to Dewberry Engineers Inc.; and

WHEREAS, On January 28, 2025, staff administratively issued (no cost) Notice to Proceed #8 shifting budget within previously authorized tasks with no change in the overall authorized contract amount; and

WHEREAS, On April 22, 2025, the City Council approved Amendment No. 9 and issuance of Notice to Proceed #9 in the amount of \$351,652.65 for additional design and right-of-way engineering services; and

WHEREAS, On July 8, 2025, staff administratively approved Amendment No. 10 and issued Notice to Proceed #10 in the amount of \$24,929.00 for additional right-of-way engineering/utility services; and

WHEREAS, Staff has determined that additional water relocation design services are needed to complete the project.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the City Council of the City of Placerville does hereby:

1. Approve Amendment No. 12 to the Consulting Services Agreement with Dewberry Engineers Inc. in the amount of \$19,000 for the Placerville Drive Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Project (CIP #41816), and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
2. Approve a Design and Construction Responsibility and Reimbursement Agreement with El Dorado Irrigation District in the amount of \$19,000 for the design services for the said project, and authorize the City Manager to execute the same; and
3. Approve a \$19,000 budget appropriation associated with the said agreement with the El Dorado Irrigation District for the said project; and
4. Authorize staff to issue Notice to Proceed #11 in the amount of \$19,000 with Dewberry Engineers, Inc. for the said project.
