Competitive Swim Clinics for Beginners

Ages 8 and up

Designed for swimmers ages 8 and up with little or no competitive swimming experience, or those who have completed the Sharks Level of swimming lessons. Swimmers will focus on building endurance through structured workouts, advanced techniques of the 4 competitive strokes, stroke coordination and efficiency, drills, racing starts and turns. Emphasis is on freestyle and backstroke, with an introduction to competitive breaststroke and butterfly. Participants should be able to swim 25 yards with ease and be confident in deep water. **Multiple session discount available!** See Page 4.

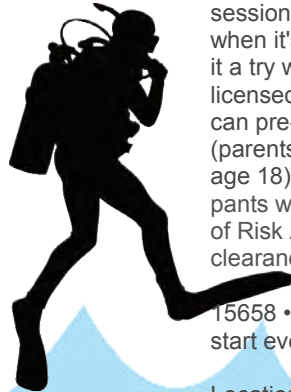

Open Water PADI SCUBA Certification

Ages 18+

This course will teach the knowledge and skills to become a fully certified open water SCUBA diver for recreation diving up to depths of 60 feet. The class is divided into three weekend sessions including classroom sessions, pool sessions, and open water sessions. Students must complete all study materials prior to the first class meeting. Open water sessions will take place in Lake Tahoe and participants will be responsible for their own transportation and park fees. Students must provide their own quality scuba mask, fins, snorkel, boots and gloves. The materials fee is paid to the instructor at the time of registration, and includes textbook, crew pack, Certification fee, and scuba gear rental for two weekends. Students must visit Fisheye SCUBA in Folsom for rental gear fitting and pickup prior to the pool and open water weekends. Participants will be required to sign an Assumption of Risk Agreement and have medical clearance to participate in this class.
