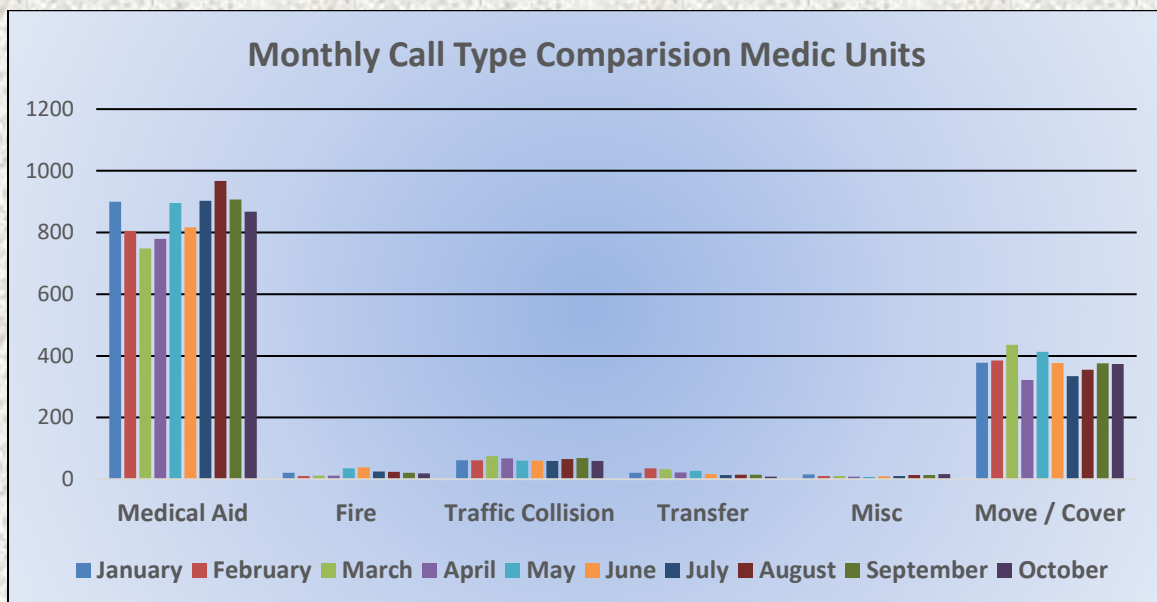
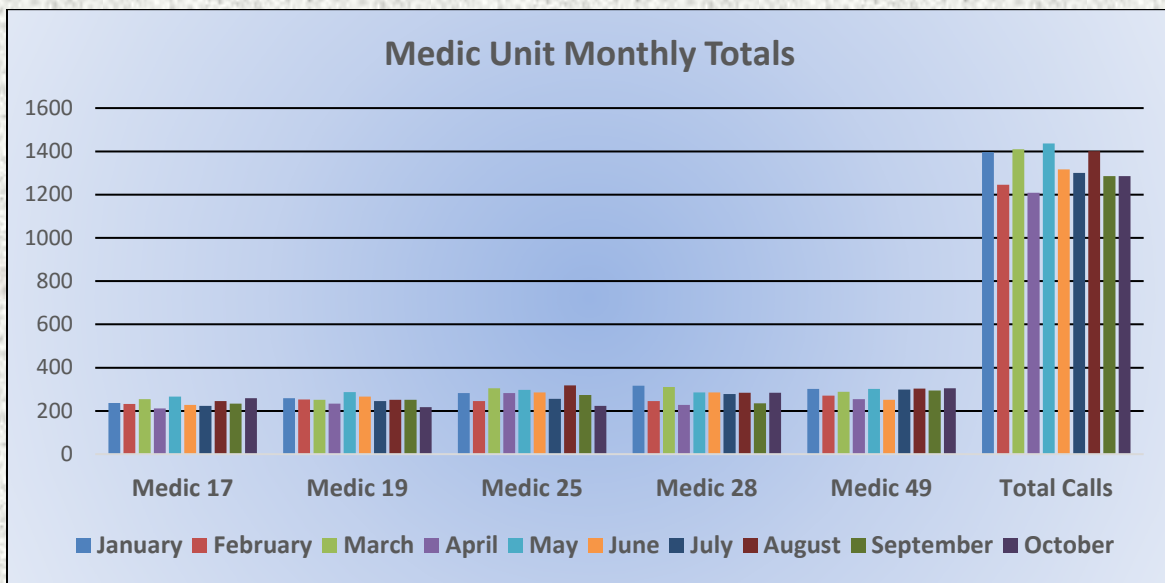

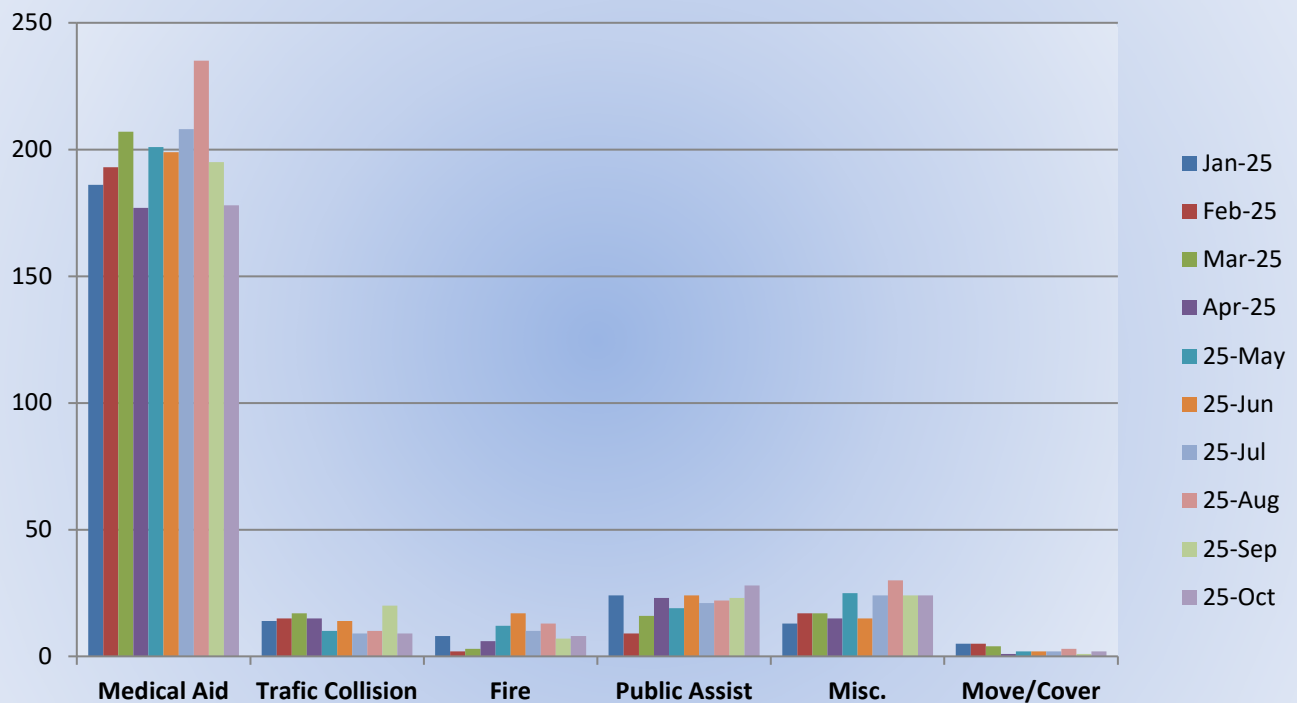


Total Responses for Medic Units: 1,286



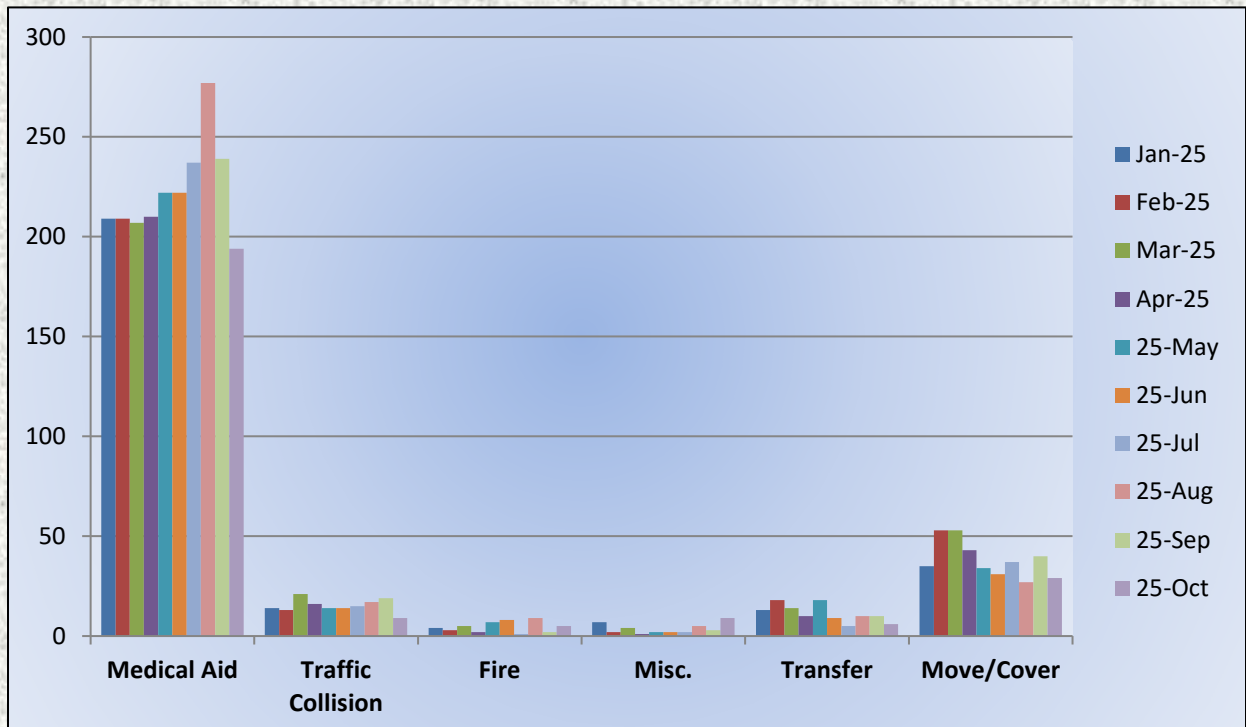
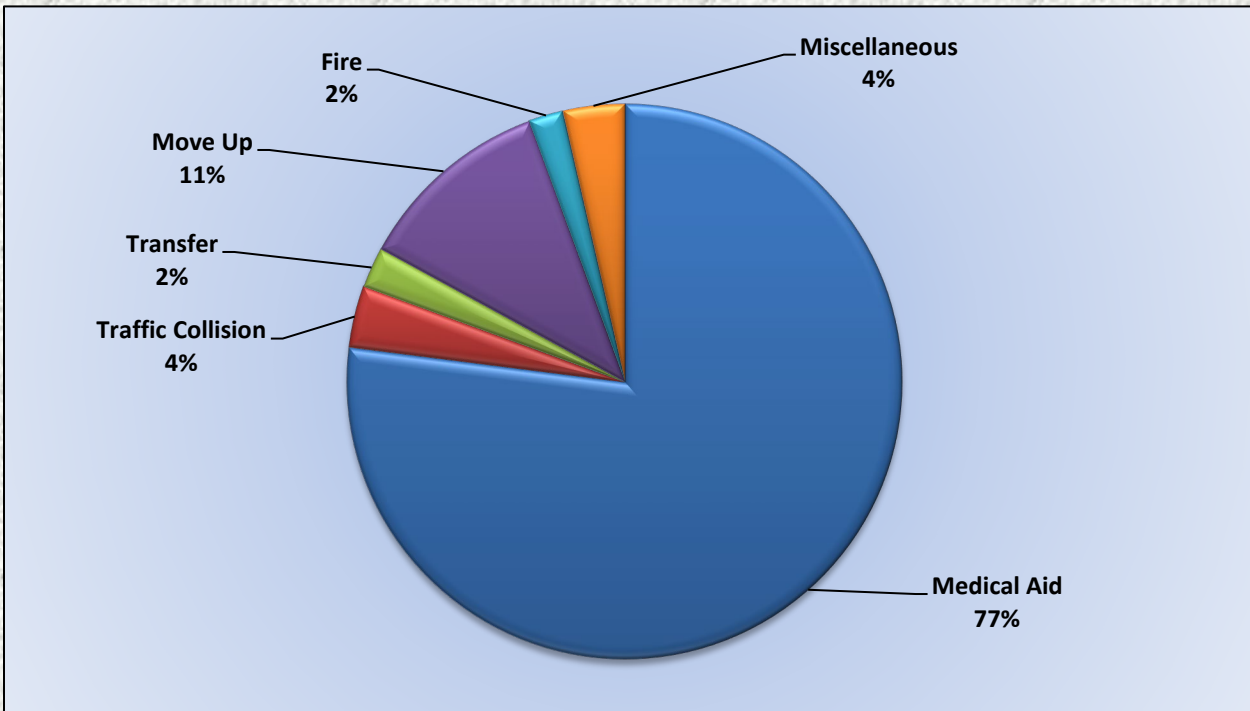
