The work for which this Proposal is submitted is for the construction in accordance with these Contract Documents (including the payment of not less than the State general prevailing wage rates or Federal minimum wage rates set forth herein), the Project Plans described below, including any addenda thereto, the Contract annexed hereto, and also in accordance with the California Department of Transportation Standard Plans and Standard Specifications, and the Labor Surcharge and Equipment Rental Rates in effect on the date the work is accomplished, and in accordance with the General Prevailing Wage rates. The Project Plans and Contract Documents for the work to be done are entitled:

BROADWAY SIDEWALKS CIP #41606

Bids are to be submitted for the entire work. The amount of the bid for comparison purposes will be the total of all the items.

The Bidder shall set forth for each unit basis item of work a unit price and a total for the item, and for each lump sum item a total for the item, all in clearly legible figures in the respective spaces provided for this purpose. In the case of unit basis items, the amount set forth under the "Item Total" column shall be the product of the unit price bid and the estimated quantity for the item.

In case of discrepancy between the item price and the total set forth for a unit basis item, the unit price shall prevail, except as provided in (a) or (b), as follows:

- (a) If the amount set forth as a unit price is unreadable or otherwise unclear, or is omitted, or is the same as the amount as the entry in the item total column, then the amount set forth in the total column for the item shall prevail and shall be divided by the estimated quantity for the item and the price thus obtained shall be the unit price;
- (b) (Decimal Errors) If the product of the entered unit price and the estimated quantity is exactly off by a factor of ten, one hundred, etc., or one-tenth, or one-hundredth, etc., from the entered total, the discrepancy will be resolved by using the entered unit price or item total, whichever most closely approximates percentage wise the unit price or item total in the Department's Final Estimate of cost.

If this Proposal is accepted and the undersigned Bidder shall fail to enter into the Contract and furnish the two bonds in the sums required by the State Contract Act, with surety satisfaction to the City of Placerville within eight days, not including Sundays and legal holidays, after the bidder has received notice from the City of Placerville that the Contract has been awarded, the City of Placerville may, at its option, determine that the Bidder has abandoned the Contract, and thereupon this Proposal and the acceptance thereof shall be null and void and the forfeiture of such security accompanying this Proposal shall operate and the same shall be the property of the City of Placerville.

The undersigned, as Bidder, declares under penalty of perjury under the laws of the State of California that the only persons or parties interested in this Proposal, as principals, are those named herein; that this Proposal is made without collusion with any other person, firm, or corporation; that he has carefully examined the location of the proposed work, the annexed proposed form of Contract, and the Plans therein referred to; and he proposes, and agrees if this Proposal is accepted, that he will contract with the City of Placerville, in the form of the copy of the Contract annexed hereto, to provide all necessary machinery, tools, apparatus, and other means of construction, and to do all the work and furnish all the materials specified in the Contract, in the manner and time therein prescribed, and according to the requirements of the Engineer as therein set forth, and that he will take in full payment therefore the following item prices, to wit:

This addendum is issued to the Broadway Sidewalks Project. Submit proposals for this work with the understanding and full consideration of this Addendum. The revisions declared in this Addendum are essential parts of the Contract.

Bidders are also directed to sign this Addendum as acknowledged, and attach the complete, signed Addendum to the Proposal.

The following changes are made to the Notice to Bidders, Contract, Proposal, Special Provisions and Project Plans Project Plans:

Notice to Bidders

Replace the paragraph in the Completion of Work section in the Notice to Bidders with the following:

COMPLETION OF WORK: Paving operations are anticipated to occur at night from the hours of 10 pm to 8 am, Sunday through Thursday. Concrete and utility work is anticipated to occur during normal working hours from 7 am to 5 pm, Monday through Friday. No work shall be performed by the Contractor on Friday nights, Saturday, or City designated holidays.

Contract

On page C-19 of the Contract, replace the second and third paragraphs with the following:

This work shall be diligently prosecuted to completion before the expiration of 90

WORKING DAYS beginning on the fifteenth calendar day after the date shown on the Notice to Proceed.

The Contractor shall pay to the City/County the sum of \$4,800.00 per day, for each and every calendar days' delay in finishing the work in excess of the number of working days prescribed above.

Proposal

Replace Contractor's Bid and Bid Price Schedule with revised Contractor's Bid and Bid Price Schedule.

Questions and Answers

The City received the following questions:

Question 1: There are no bid items for permanent pavement delineations. It seems all pavement delineations will be done on Broadway Maintenance contract. If so, can the striping plans be removed from the Broadway Sidewalks project?

City's response to Question 1: Depending on the sequence of work, temporary pavement markings and temporary traffic stripe shown in the Broadway Sidewalks plans may not be necessary. City encourages the Contractor to coordinate with Contractor for the Broadway Maintenance project to minimize the need for temporary pavement markings and temporary traffic stripes.

Question 2: What items are included in the Connect to Existing Water System bid item? City's response to Question 2: Refer to page SP-44 of the Special Provisions for details on what is included in the Connect to Existing Water System bid item.

Project Plans

The following sheets of the original Project Plans have been modified as follows:

- Sheet C04: Revised pipe zone bedding materials for both water and storm drain. Pipe zone backfill shall be 3/4 inch Class II AB.
- Sheet C09: Modified Construction Note 6. The City has already replaced the damaged fire hydrant at Station 26+53, in front of 1270 Broadway. This hydrant should be reconnected to the main as indicated in the image and revised Special Provisions (below):





Special Provisions

Modifications to the Special Provisions are as follows:

Add to Section 19 EARTHWORK:

Add to section 19-1.03:

It is anticipated that all excavating efforts will be achievable by use of a medium sized excavator, such as a CAT 325 excavator with rock bucket, or other industry approved piece of similar equipment.

- Add to Section 77-4.02B(6)(c) MATERIALS: Insertion valve shall be either Hydra Stop Instavalve 250, Mueller Permaseal Insertion Valve, Romac Industries Inserta Valve, or approved equal. Insertion valve to be installed per manufacturer's specifications.
- Replace the fourth (4th) paragraph in section 77-4.04 PAYMENT with: The 10" Gate Valve and Insertion Valve bid items shall be paid for on a per unit basis. Measurement shall be based on the actual number of Gate Valves and Insertion Valves installed. The contract unit price paid for each 10" Gate Valve and Insertion Valve shall include full compensation for all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved, complete and in place, as specified per Section 3.6 and EID Standard Drawing W12 of the EI Dorado Irrigation District Design Standards and as directed by the City Engineer and Department of Public Works, manufacturer's specifications and no additional compensation will be allowed.
- Replace the paragraphs in Section 77-5.02 CONSTRUCTION with:
 Contractor is to install a fire hydrant valve at the location indicated in the project plans, in front of 1270 Broadway. Contractor is to expose the existing hydrant lateral and locate the existing cap in the lateral, remove cap, and install new hydrant valve.

Materials which are lost for any reason, and components which are damaged beyond repair as a result of the Contractor's operations shall be either replaced by the Contractor, at his expense. Replacement for lost or damaged components shall be of the same kind and of the same or better quality and condition as the lost or damaged materials were prior to their removal.

• Replace the paragraph in Section 77-5.03 PAYMENT with: The Install Fire Hydrant Valve bid item shall be paid for by lump sum. The contract unit price paid for Install Fire Hydrant Valve shall include full compensation for all labor, materials, tools, equipment and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved, complete and in place, as specified per EID Standard Drawing W17 of the EI Dorado Irrigation District Design Standards and as directed by the City Engineer and Department of Public Works, Project Plans and Special Provisions and no additional compensation will be allowed. Work involved includes and is not limited to: furnishing all labor, materials, tools, equipment, and incidentals, and for doing all the work involved in installing the hydrant valve, including all sawcutting; excavation; backfill; locating, cutting, removing, and disposing existing cap on hydrant lateral; new hydrant lateral piping as needed; new hydrant valve; reconnecting relocated hydrant to existing fire service line, disposal of excess materials, and any necessary surface restoration. Add to section 77-1.02B Pipe Zone
 Material for the pipe zones for water service lines shall be consistent with Section 19-3.02F(2) of the Caltrans standards Specifications:

Sand bedding must consist of sand:

- 1. Free of clay or organic material
- 2. Suitable for the purpose intended
- 3. Complying with the gradation requirements shown in the following table:
